## What does your school have to do?

- Submit an application form by March 31;

- Commit teaching staff to participate in the training workshop and program evaluations.

## Selection Process:

To qualify your school must:

- Fill out a complete application form;
- Identify three potential dates for a minimum 4 hour staff workshop (Pro D days, after school, evening or weekends) between August - March.

Preference will be given to schools:

- With greatest staff participation;
- With an expressed interest in integrating active science learning;
- From a variety of school districts.
