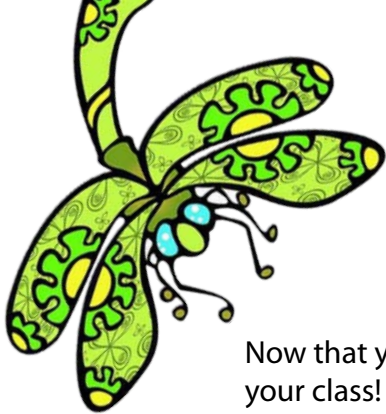

**Criteria for field trips:**

- Must be outdoors
- Must have a physically active component
- Must relate to your Science in Action theme

**Covers:**

- All or portion of **bus cost**, receipt required
- All or portion of **student program cost** at field site, receipt required

**Doesn't cover:**

- Materials
- Programs not associated with SIA or linked to SIA goals

**Claim:**

- School or school district submits invoice with copy of bus or program receipt to WildBC for reimbursement. Allow 6 weeks to process.

*If you have remaining support time, your facilitator may be able to assist in field trip planning.*

**5 hours of Outdoor  
Support by WildBC Facilitator**

**Criteria for Additional Facilitator Support:**
